

Block Watchers

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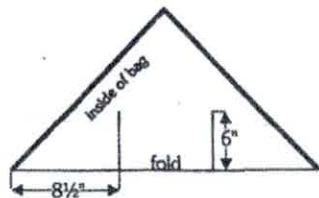
The 3 Pocket Bag

Materials:

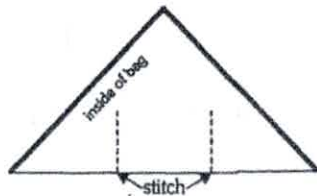
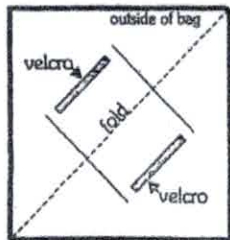
- 18" square of quilted fabric
- 2 1/8 yards of 2 1/2" binding
- 9" of sew in velcro
- thread

Instructions:

1. Apply the binding to the edge of the quilted fabric, mitering the corners.
2. Fold the square in half to form a triangle, with right sides together.



3. Measure 8 1/2" from each point along the fold and mark. From those marks measure up 6" and mark a line. Transfer the lines to the outside of the bag.
4. On the outside of the bag, center a 6" piece of velcro on each side between the markings, having the top edge of the velcro even with the top of the 6" marks. Stitch the velcro in place.

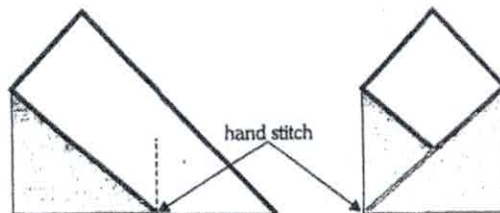


5. Re-fold the triangle with right sides together, matching the velcro. Stitch on the 6" lines, backstitching on both ends.

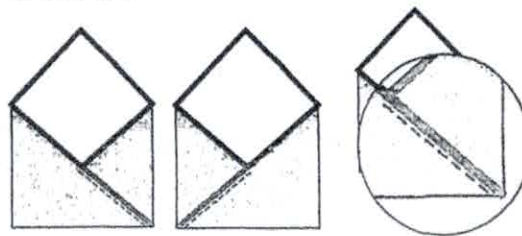


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6. Reach inside the left corner, grab the seam and pull the point of the triangle, folding it back over the center section of the bag. Press. Both sides of the bag will be identical.



7. Repeat the folding process for the opposite side.
8. Hand stitch the triangle points to the base of the bag. Stitch in the ditch by hand through the outer two layers on each pocket.



9. Fold the top points down to 1/8" above the velcro. Press.

10. Secure the outside flaps with a small square of velcro or a button.
